Note: Asbestos as a binding agent is used in a myriad of applications, not just in building materials, tiles or insulation. Asbestos has been used in a wide number of products due to its flexibility, tensile strength, insulation, chemical inertness and affordability and is still used outside Australia in many instances. A list of goods that might contain asbestos or asbestos containing material (ACM) can be found on the above ABF link. The list is non-exhaustive and subject to change. It should be used as a guide only. Asbestos and asbestos containing material is a prohibited import, it should not be imported absolutely, with zero tolerance in Australia. The Australian Border Force make no apology for enforcing these measures and harsh penalties will apply if asbestos is found.
